**NJDEP UST Recertification Course**

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) regulates individuals who perform services on Underground Storage Tanks (USTs). This program satisfies the NJDEP regulatory requirement for certified individuals to complete UST recertification training every three years within the 12 months prior to their certification's renewal. This course is also approved for 5.5 hours of regulatory CECs for Licensed Site Remediation Professionals (LSRP). Certified individuals are reminded they are also responsible for staying current with OSHA CFR 1919.120 HazWoper Training. **If you work on USTs, you need this course!**

This program not only satisfies the requirements for certification renewal, it includes a specific emphasis on changes and compliance for regulated USTs and the new rules for unregulated UST remediations.

\* **Regulated Tanks N.J.A.C. 7:14B:** New Jersey's regulated UST rules were published in January 2018. The rules include operator training requirements and the periodic facility inspection and maintenance requirements. The new tank rules continue to present challenges on a variety of levels. This course will include special emphasis on the current NJDEP compliance initiatives and discussion on compliance alternatives for regulated sites.

\* **Unregulated Tanks-N.J.A.C. 7:26F:** The NJDEP has adopted a regulation specific to addressing unregulated heating oil tank system (now referred to as HOTS) releases. This course will present an overview of the new requirements including those specific to complying with EPH Standards included in the rule and the status of the EPH guidance.

This course will be facilitated by John Donohue, J. Donohue Associates LLC, Chris Dwyer, Supervising Environmental Specialist Unregulated Heating Oil Tank Program (UHOT) as well as LSRPs, and remediation and system design specialists. Staff members from the NJDEP Regulated UST Facility Compliance and Enforcement program will be present as well.
